
A WALK IN THE PARK


MOUNT PISGAH



SARANAC WATERFRONT LODGE





BAKER MT.

Want to hike a mountain but still make it to the brewery by happy hour? This short hike, just minutes from downtown, is the perfect opportunity to get out in nature, take in a great view of Saranac Lake from the top, and be sitting down for a cool beverage before the sun sets.

ROUND TRIP: 1.8 miles • **ASCENT:** 884'

ELEVATION: 2452'

DISTANCE FROM DOWNTOWN: 0.9 miles

AMPERSAND MT.

Looking for something a little more adventurous? Ampersand delivers. It may seem like just a casual walk in the woods at the start, but the second half of this hike becomes steep and rugged. The sweat and heartache is worth it however, as the completely bald summit offers a 360 degree view of the High Peaks and the Saranac Chain of Lakes.

ROUND TRIP: 5.4 miles • **ASCENT:** 2221'

ELEVATION: 3822'

DISTANCE FROM DOWNTOWN: 5 miles

ST. REGIS MT.

Who knew combining history and athletic activity could be so much fun! With a fire tower at the top of this peak, you can imagine what life was like for a fire warden—before the fire department was just a phone call away. Take in views of the St. Regis Canoe Area, as you enjoy the 102-year-old structure. This steep climb is well worth it!

ROUND TRIP: 6.8 miles • **ASCENT:** 1266'

ELEVATION: 2874'

DISTANCE FROM DOWNTOWN: 14.6 miles

JACKRABBIT TRAIL

If mountains aren't your thing, the Jackrabbit Trail might be what you're looking for. With over 30 miles of flatter trail, the Jackrabbit links Keene, Lake Placid, Saranac Lake, and Paul Smiths. Whether you're a walker, hiker, skier, or snowshoer, the Jackrabbit Trail provides beautiful views and fresh air from dozens of access points throughout the area.





DRIVING

From Montreal: Take Autoroute 15 south to the Champlain border crossing. Connect with I-87 south. Take Exit 38 to State Rt. 374 west to State Rt. 3 west to Saranac Lake. (2 hours)

From the Metropolitan NY & NJ area: Take I-87 north through the Albany area and continue north to Exit 30. Follow US Rt. 9N to State Rt. 73 into Lake Placid and west on State Rt. 86 to Saranac Lake. (+/- 6 hours)

From the Buffalo, Rochester & Syracuse areas: Take the NYS Thruway (I-90) east to I-81 in Syracuse. Follow I-81 north to Watertown, then State Rt. 3 east to Saranac Lake. (+/- 4 hours from Syracuse)

From Ottawa: Take routes south to the Cornwall bridge. Take Rt. 37 east to Malone then State Rt. 30 south to State Rt. 86 at Paul Smiths, then east to Saranac Lake. (+/- 3 hours)

AIR SERVICE

The Adirondack Regional Airport in Lake Clear (SLK), the only commercial airport in the Adirondacks, is just a 10-minute drive from Saranac Lake. Cape Air offers daily flights from Boston's Logan International Airport.

Full general aviation services for private planes are also available, and the runway can accommodate charter and general aviation aircraft up to and including Boeing 757s.

Rental cars, taxis and limousines, and ride-sharing services such as Uber and Lyft are available.
